Conditions of Play 2026

- 1) This is a fun league with just a hint of competition with the focus on getting the most bowlers playing as possible. Play will follow the WLBC Conditions of Play unless otherwise stipulated below.
- 2) The first session will begin on Tuesday, May 19th and go for 9 weeks
- 3) The second session will begin on Tuesday, July 21st and go for 9 weeks
- 4) There will be one night of overall playoffs held on Tuesday, September 29th.
- 5) There will be a non-points fun night on Tuesday August 25th so as to not disadvantage volunteers for the Canadian Seniors being held at WLBC who don't want to spend the whole day and evening at the club. There will be play but no points awarded.
- 6) Start time each Tuesday will be 7:00 PM. Arrive early so the draw can be completed on time
- 7) There will be a spider competition prior to the regular games
- 8) The entry fee each night will be \$2 with all money going to prizes at the end of each session, final playoffs and for spiders
- 9) Prizes will be awarded to the top 6 players in the first session and the second session
- 10) You must attend at least 50% of the games in a session to be eligible for session prizes
- 11) There will be an overall playoff involving the top 12 overall point earners for both halves combined. To determine the overall points for the playoffs, the 5 worst results will be dropped from each player with the remaining results totalled.
- 12) The playoffs will be the 1st and 4th against the 2nd and 3rd, the 5th and 8th against the 6th and 7th and the 9th and 12th against the 10th and 11th.
- 13) You must attend at least 50% of the games in the overall season to be eligible for the playoffs
- 14) The position tie breakers in order are:
 - a) Most wins
 - b) Most ties
 - c) Most attendance (any night that points are awarded)
 - d) Highest points differential (points scored for minus points scored against)
 - e) Highest points aggregate (points scored for divided by points scored against)
 - f) Card draw
- 15) There will be 1 game of various formats per week with a random draw prior to set teams
- 16) Once teams are drawn players can play in any position as they agree amongst themselves
- 17) Tie games are not broken
- 18) Once the draw has begun, if games are suspended before they are official then those players in the draw are awarded 1 point
- 19) Players receive 3 points for a win, 2 points for a tie and 1 point for a loss
- 20) If a game has completed at least 50% of ends, then it is considered official
- 21) If an official game is suspended then the score when suspended is used for determining points
- 22) If at least 50% of the games are official then normal points are awarded for those games. In the unofficial games every player receives 1 point
- 23) There are 3 trophies awarded at the end of the season: top point earner with no dropped weeks, winner of the 1-4 vs 2-3 playoff game and the top novice point earner with no dropped weeks.
- 24) Comments and suggestions are always welcome and will be given the consideration they are due.
